

BC Grant for Home Modification

Did you know there is a program called the BC Rebate for Accessible Home Adaptations (RAHA). RAHA provides financial assistance/rebates to eligible low-income individuals to complete home adaptations for independent living.

As a homeowner or a tenant, individuals may be eligible for RAHA if they or someone in their household has a permanent disability or loss of physical abilities and they meet the application requirements.

Examples of some accessible modifications could include installing permanent grab bars, converting tubs to walk in showers, ramps, railings, or relocating laundry machines.

In order to be considered for funding for the RAHA program, an Occupational Therapist needs to assess your home and your function within your home in order to make recommendations for increased safety and independence.

Our company has many Occupational Therapists around British Columbia who would be happy to complete the RAHA assessment and application to facilitate safe, independent living.

The cost of the Occupational Therapy assessment is \$300, which RAHA will reimburse once the application is approved.
